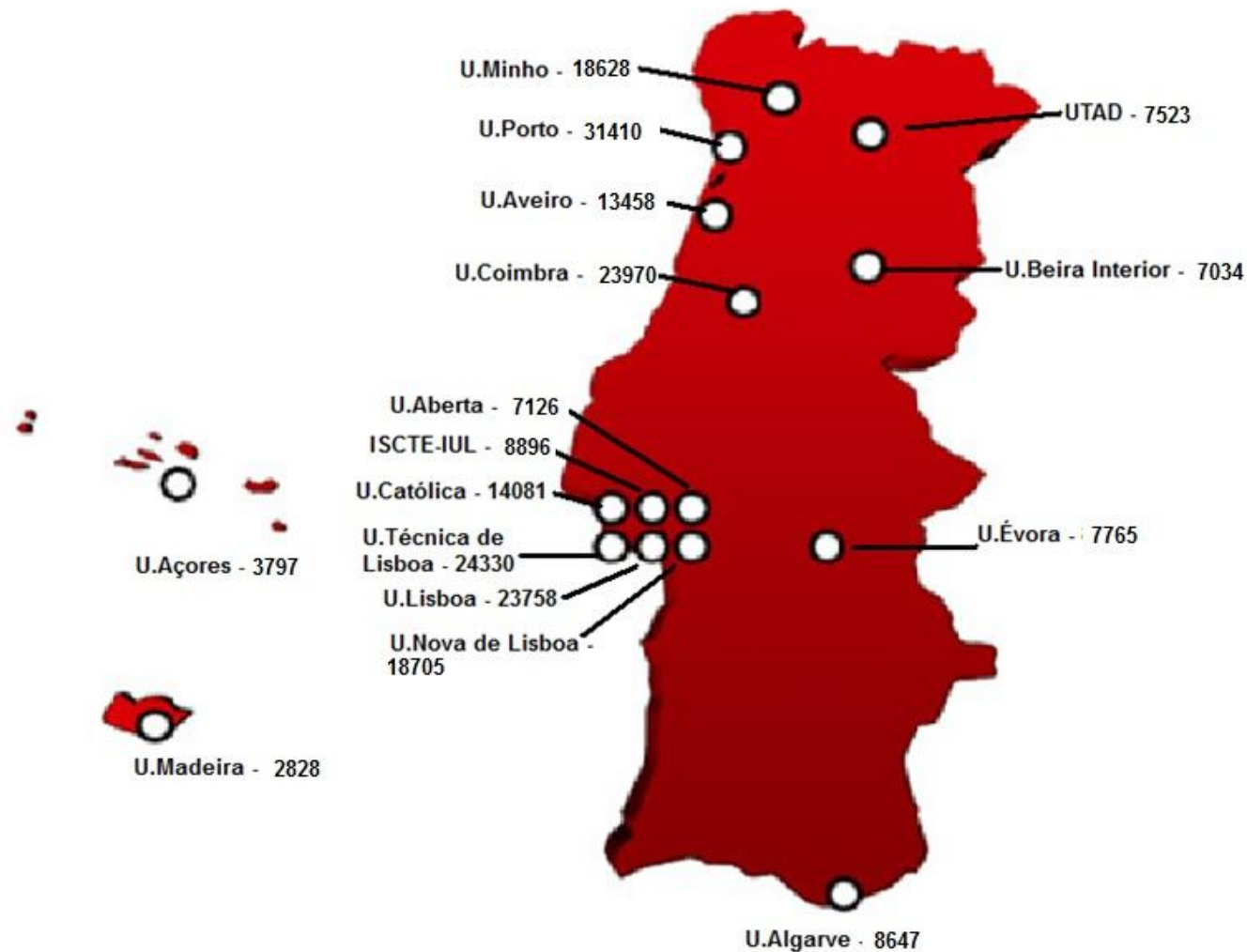
Main Tasks

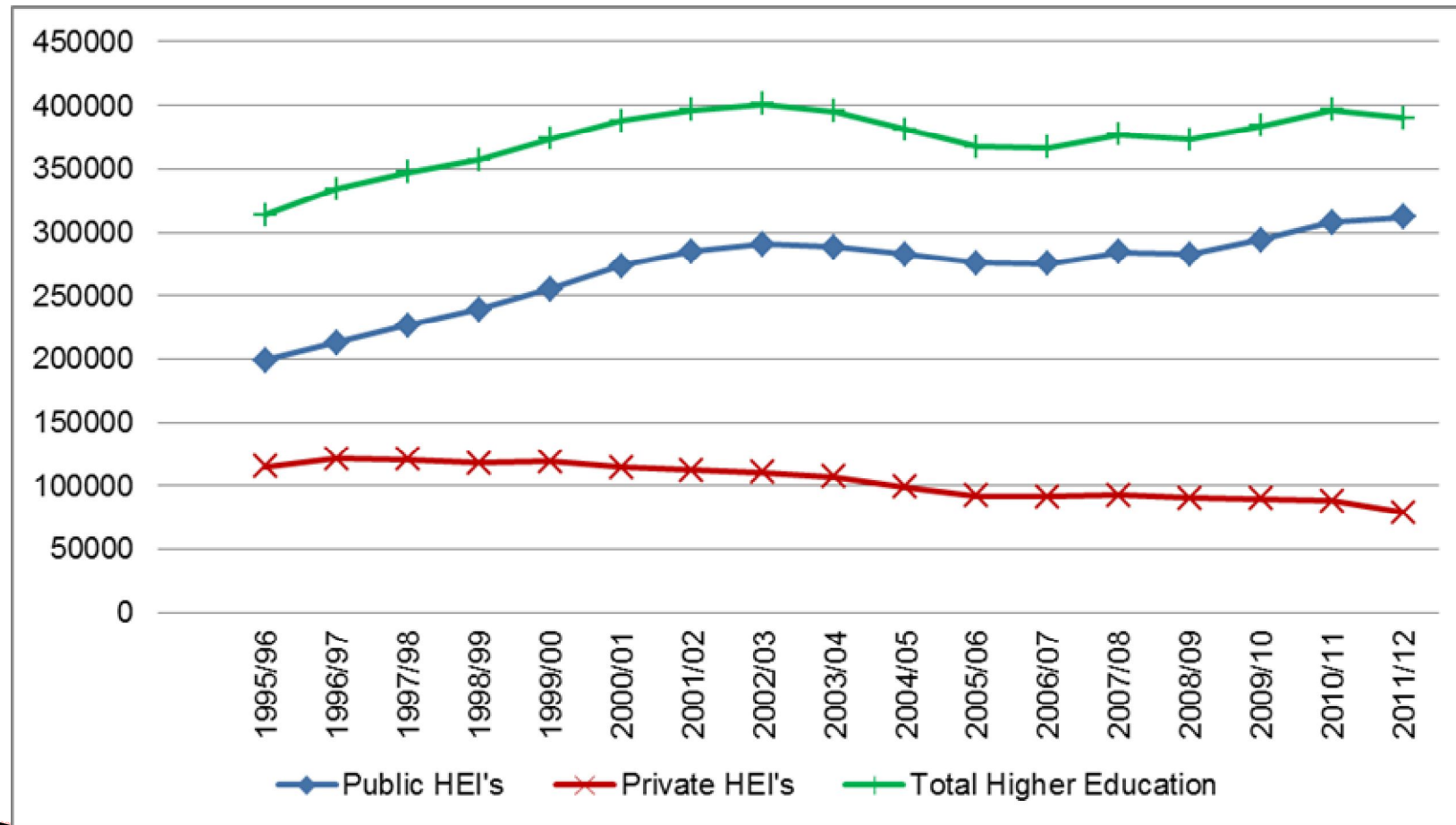
Number of students in each public university, 2012/13

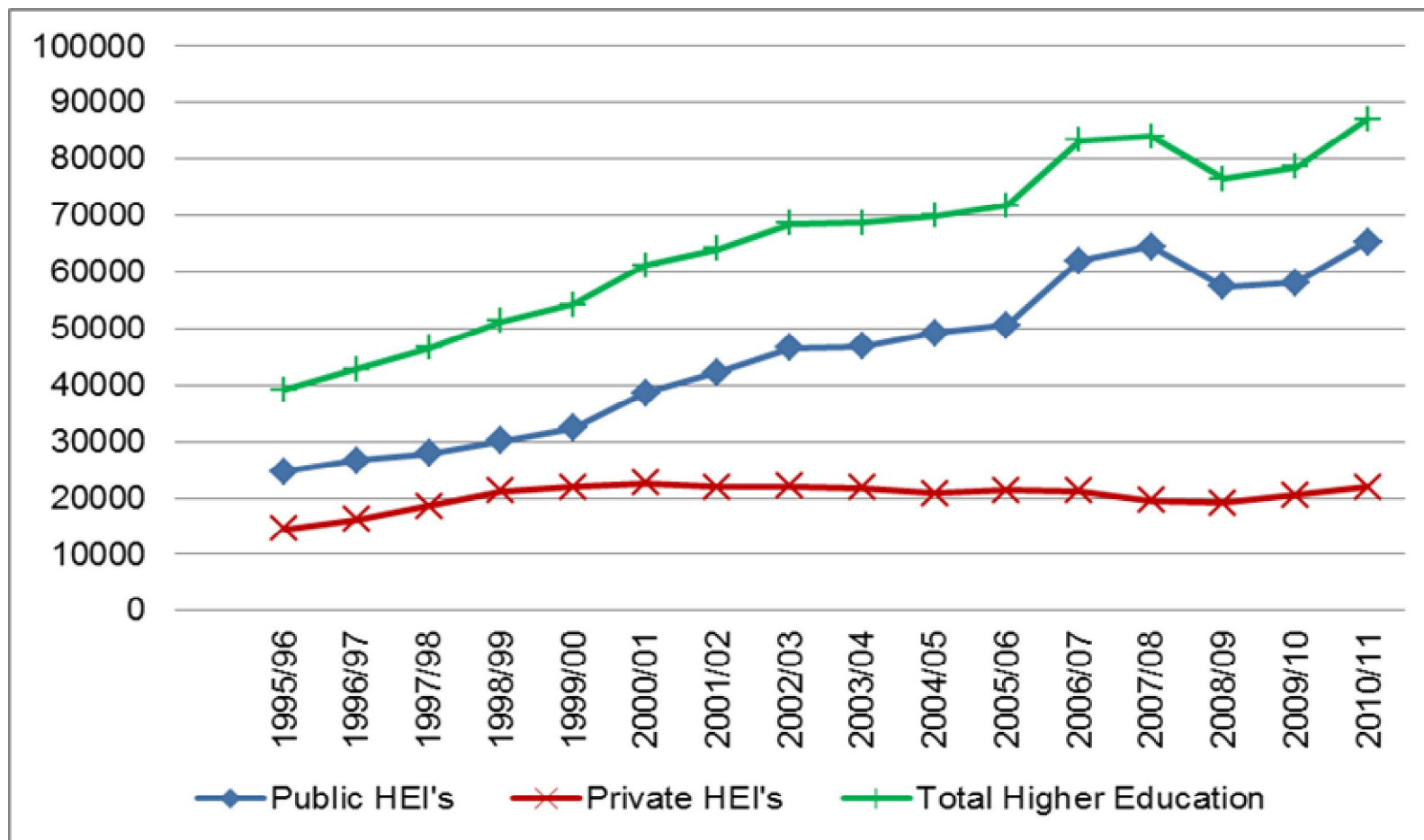
Number of students in Public HEI's and in Private HEI's,

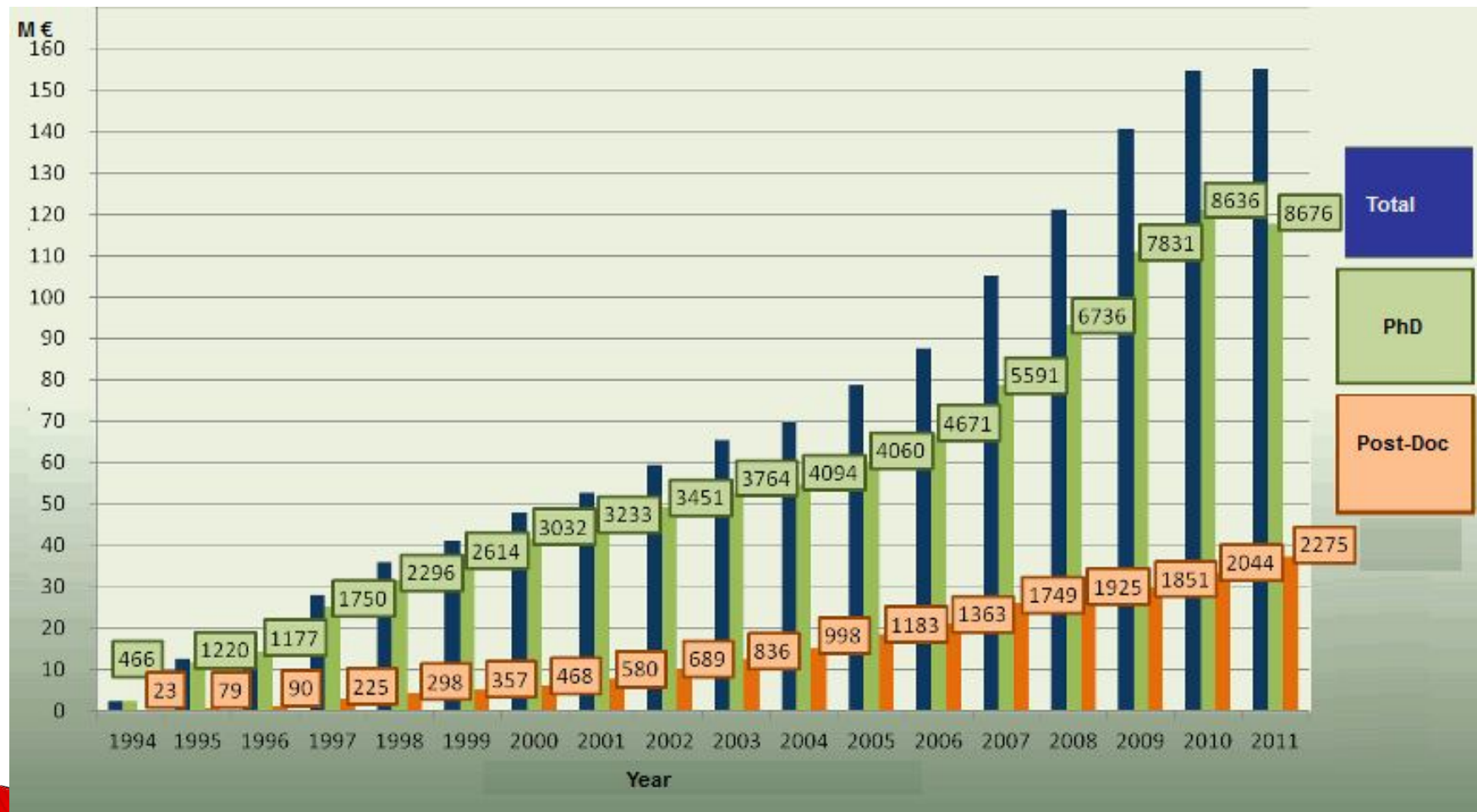
Number of graduates in Public HEI's and in Private HEI's,

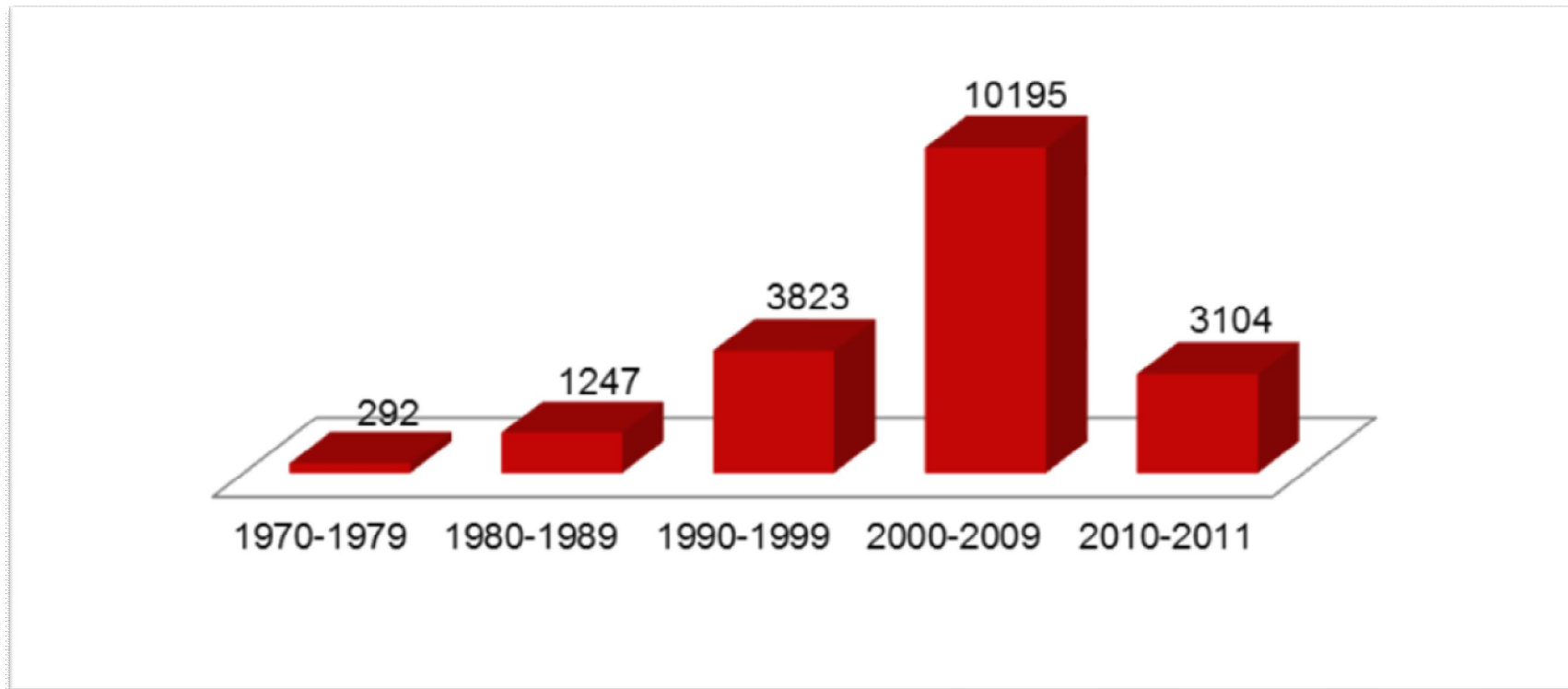
Number of active grants between 1994 and 2011

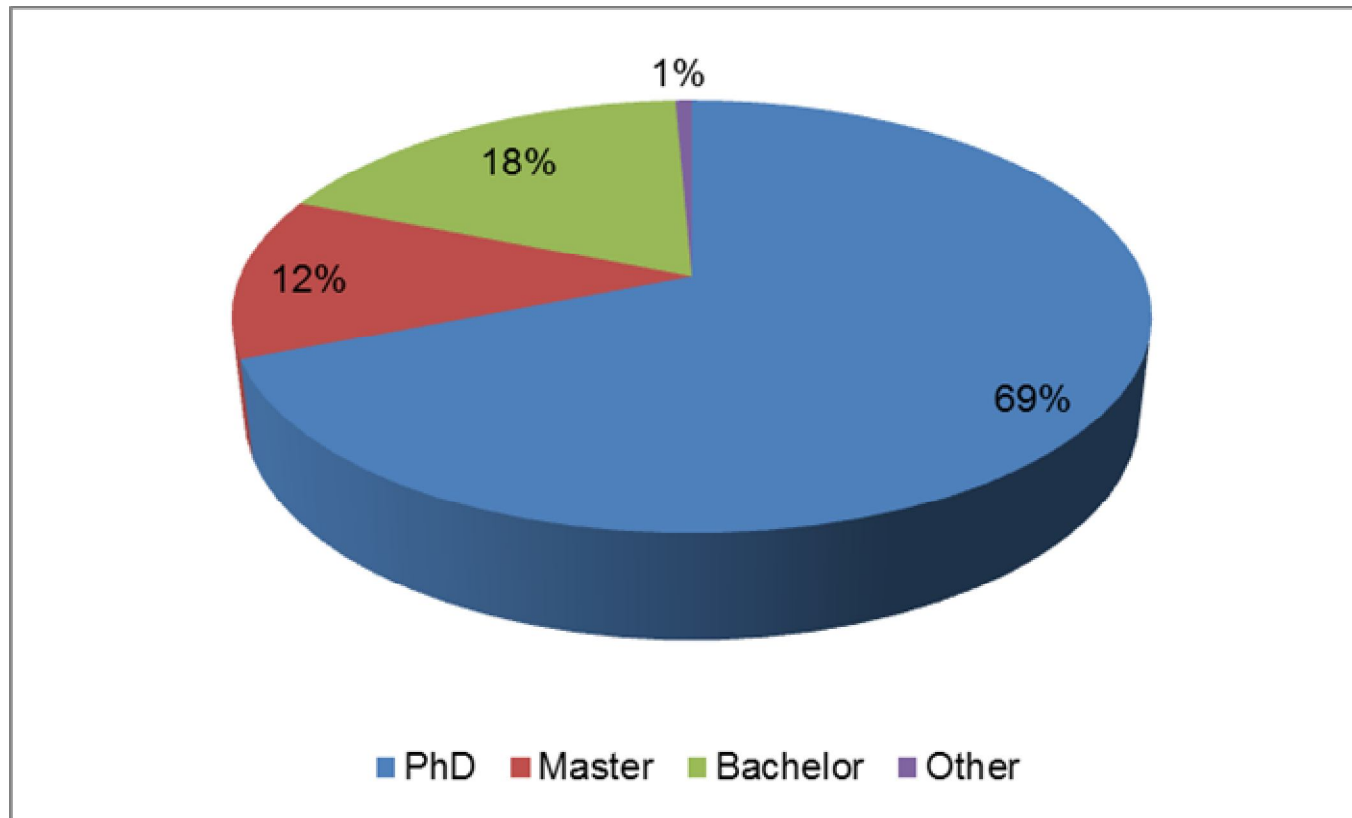
Number of PhD's completed in portuguese universities,

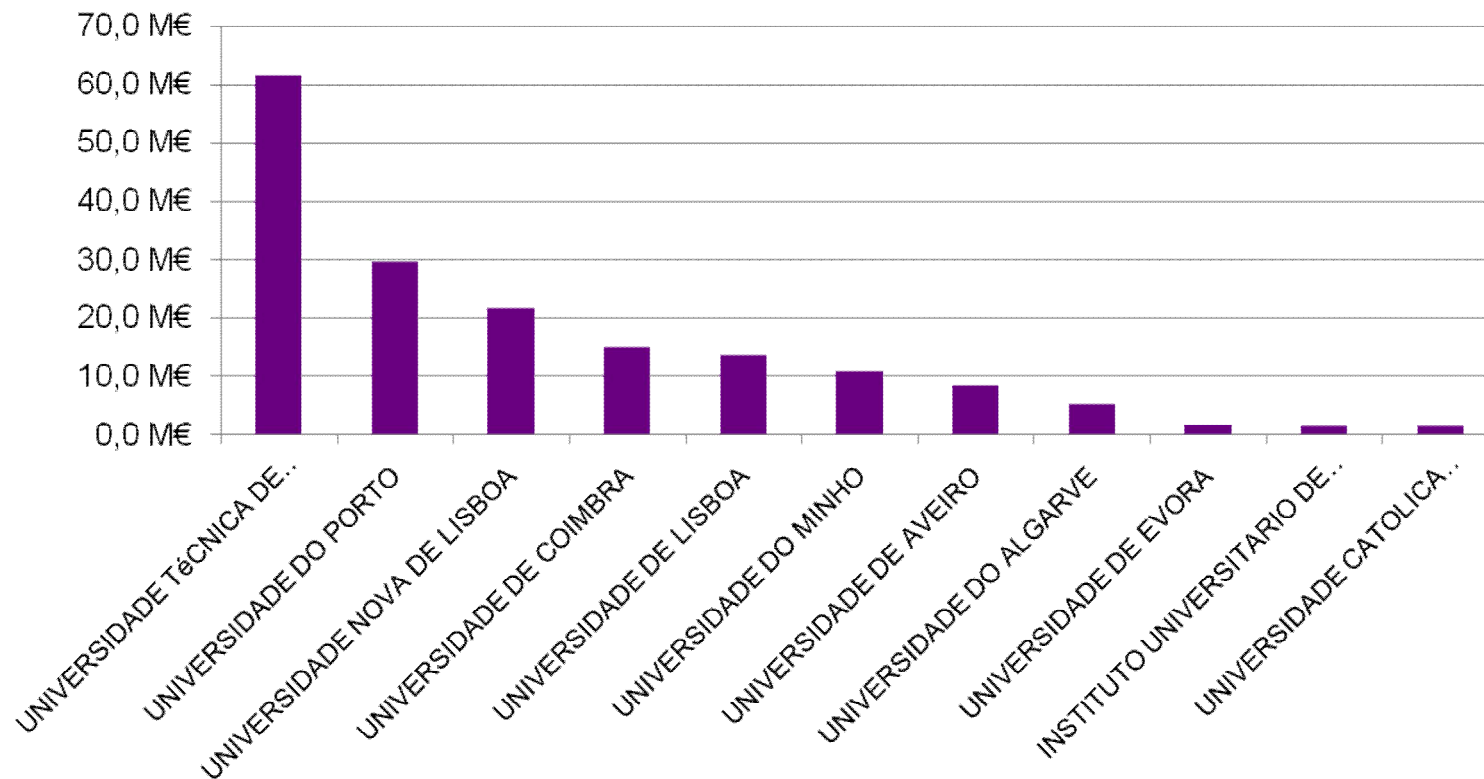

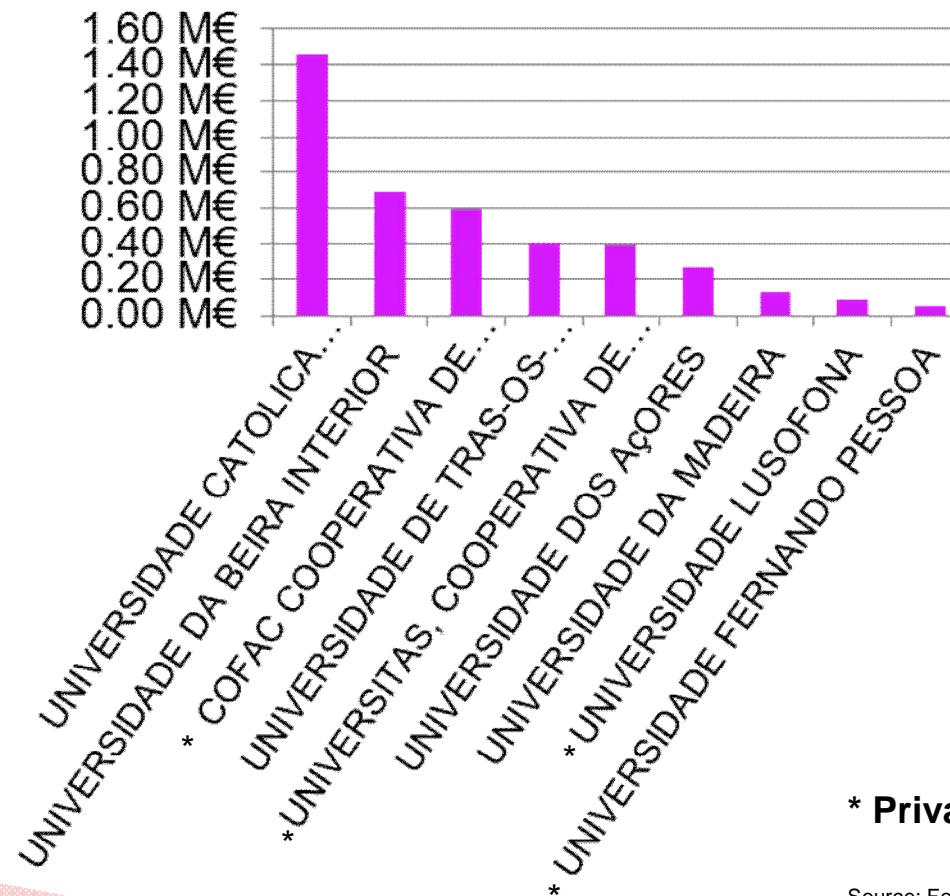
Financing of FP 7 to universities (>1,4M€), 2007/2012
