2010 Work Programme & call publications

- All five work programmes adopted end of July 2009
- 51 calls for proposals were published on 30 July
- These calls represent a total Community financial contribution of €4.1 bn.
- Included a substantial allocation of €268m, designed to help trigger economic recovery through public-private partnerships
 - "Green Car"
 - "Factory of the Future"
 - "Energy efficient buildings"

FP7 Progress Report Characteristics

- First comprehensive assessment of FP7 implementation
- Based on data and evidence
- Responding to the requirements in the FP decision (objectives, new instruments, simplification)
- Bridging towards FP7 Interim Evaluation

FP7 Progress Report

FP7 Implementation

- Evidence from 2007 and 2008 indicates overall a good start for FP7:
 - 110 calls, 36.000 proposals, 5.500 retained proposals
 - Success rate (at final stage) 21.7%
 - Over 90% of evaluators rate FP evaluation system similar or better to national system
 - (“Adjusted”) SME participation around 11%
 - 25.8% female participants
 - Redress procedure led to 11 re-evaluations (0.04%)
 - But at 329 days, average “Time to grant” still too high
 - Note already some improvement compared to FP6...(c. 370days)

Population -Proposals

109 concluded FP7 calls for proposals published in 2007-8
(on E-CORDA since 25 February 2009)

➤ 33.616 <u>eligible</u> proposals	➔	5.477 retained for funding	16%
➤ 170.048 applicants	➔	34.438 successful applicants	20%
➤ EUR 56,7 billion	➔	EUR 10,0 billion of EC funding	18%

- 21.497 grant holders

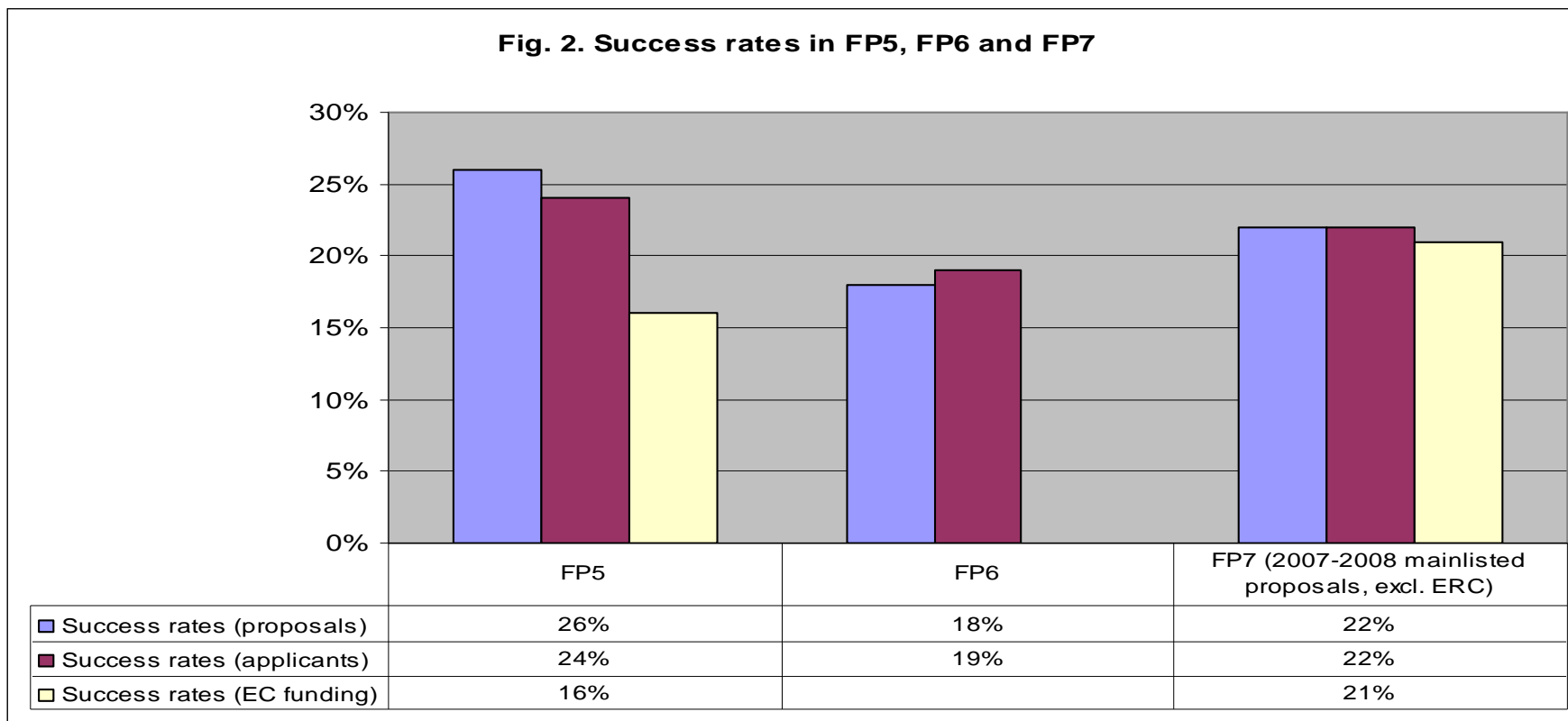


FP7 Success rates (excl. IDEAS)

- 22% successful applicants
- 21% EC funding requested by successful applicants

Fig. 2. Success rates in FP5, FP6 and FP7

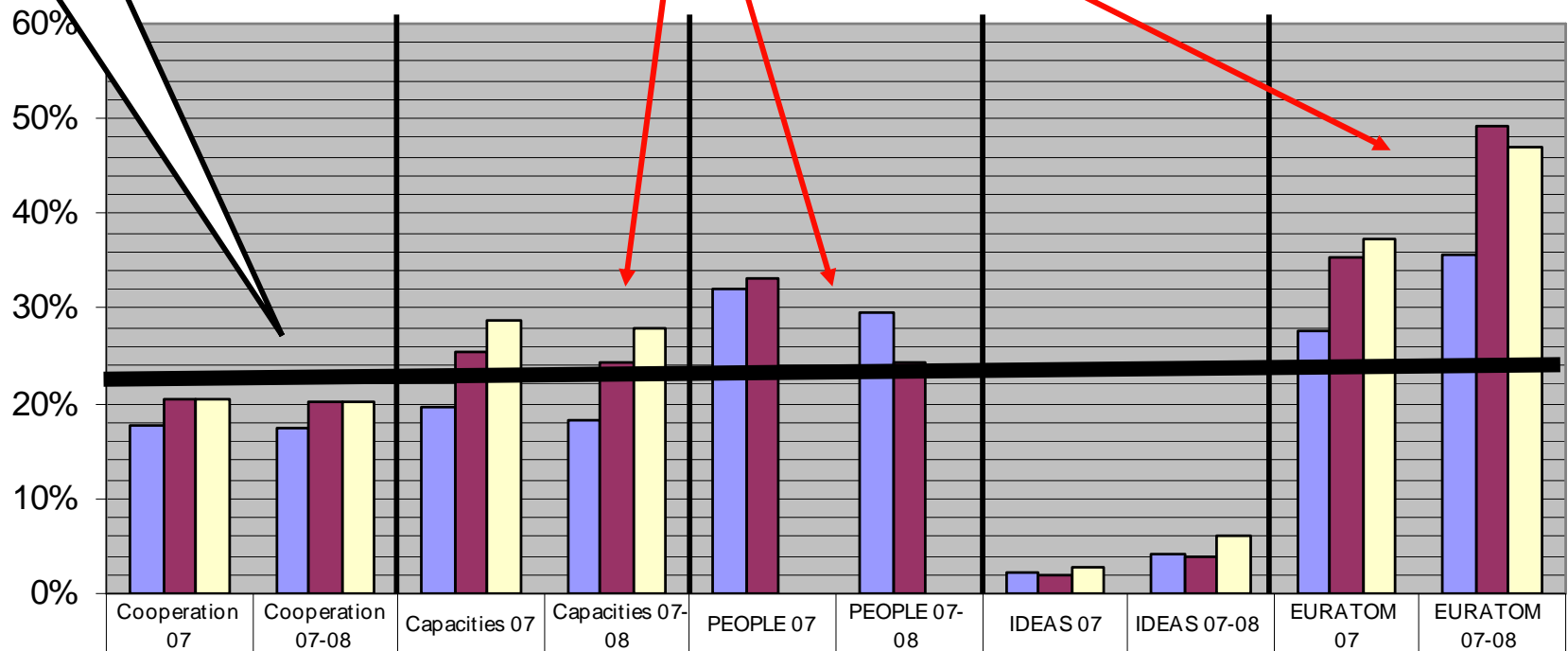




Euratom, Capacities and PEOPLE still with highest success rates

FP7 success rates by specific programme in 2007 and 2007-8

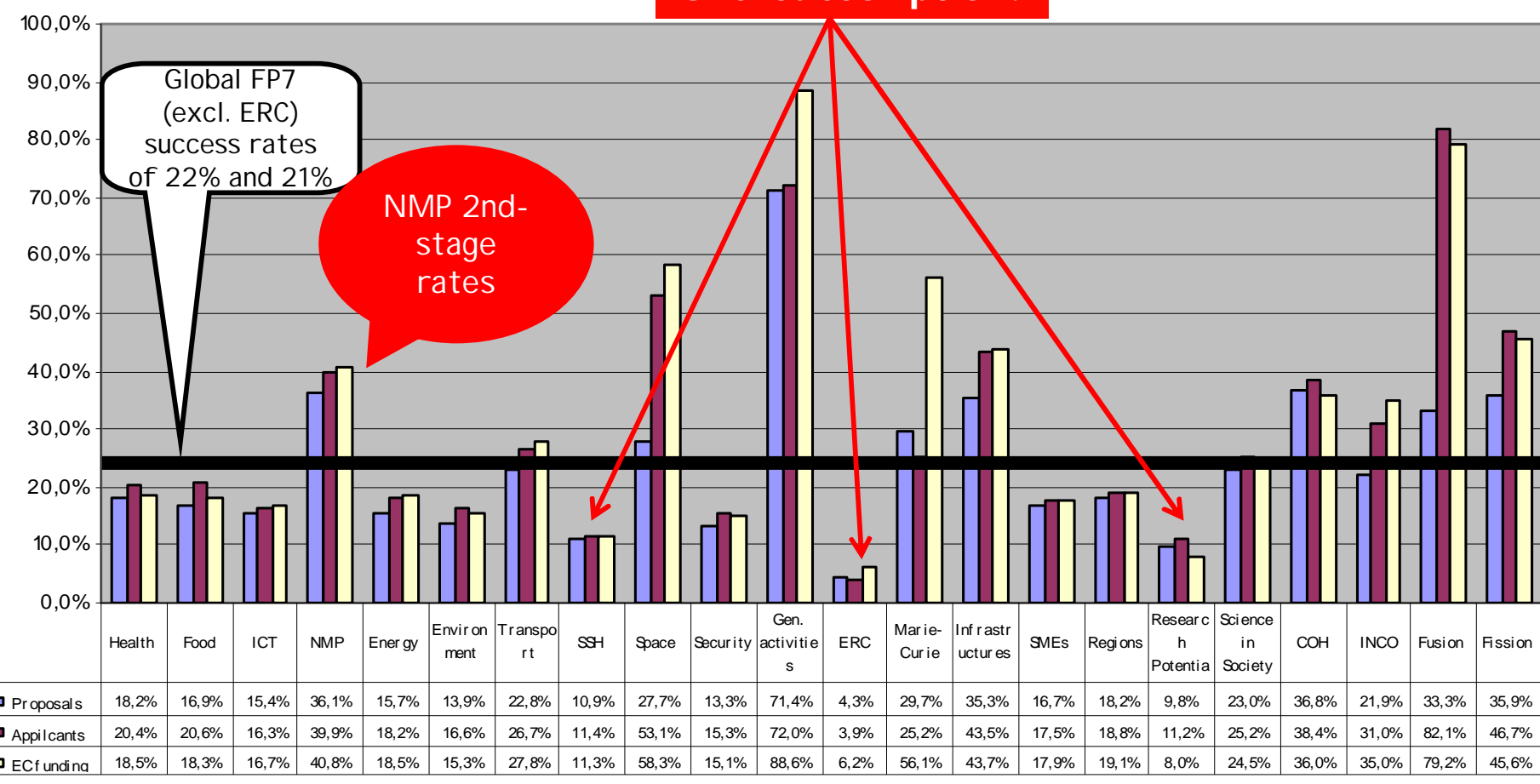

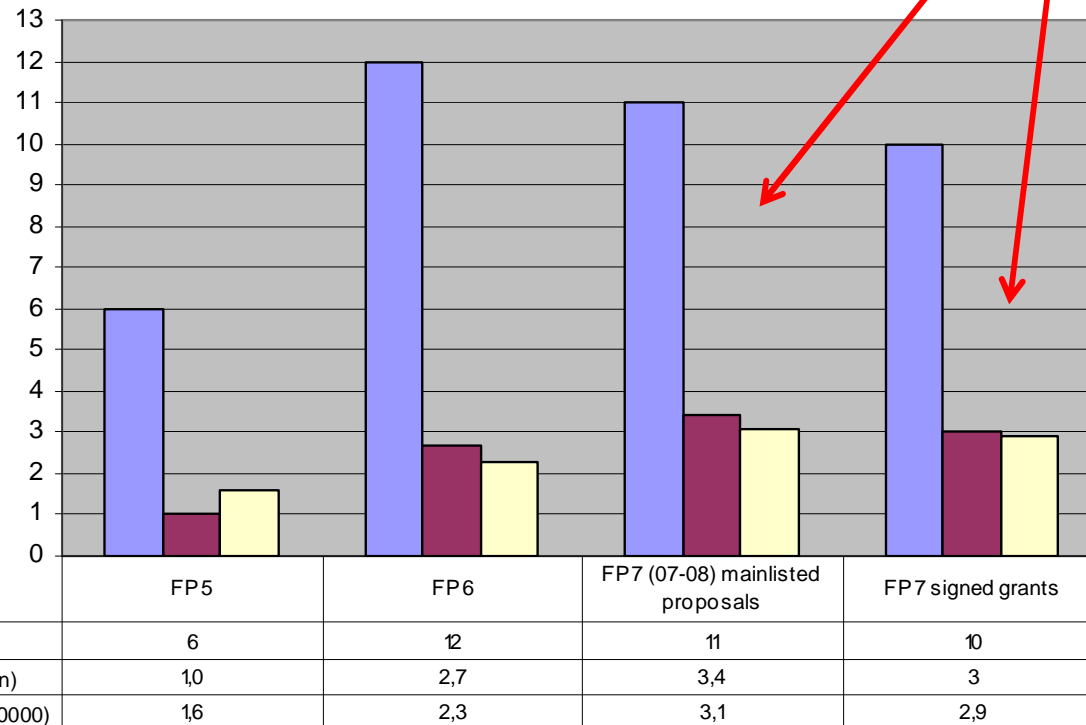


FP7 grants vs FP6 contracts: Slightly less partners

Contrary to the overall FP7 trend,
grants for Collaborative Projects involve more participants, more overall budget but less EC funding per partner than in FP6

An FP7 signed grant for a Collaborative Project:

- 12 partners
- EUR 4.0 million of EC contribution
- EUR 350,000 of EC contribution per partner

An FP6 contract (STP and IP):

- 9 partners
- EUR 3.7 million of EC contribution
- EUR 420,000 of EC contribution per partner

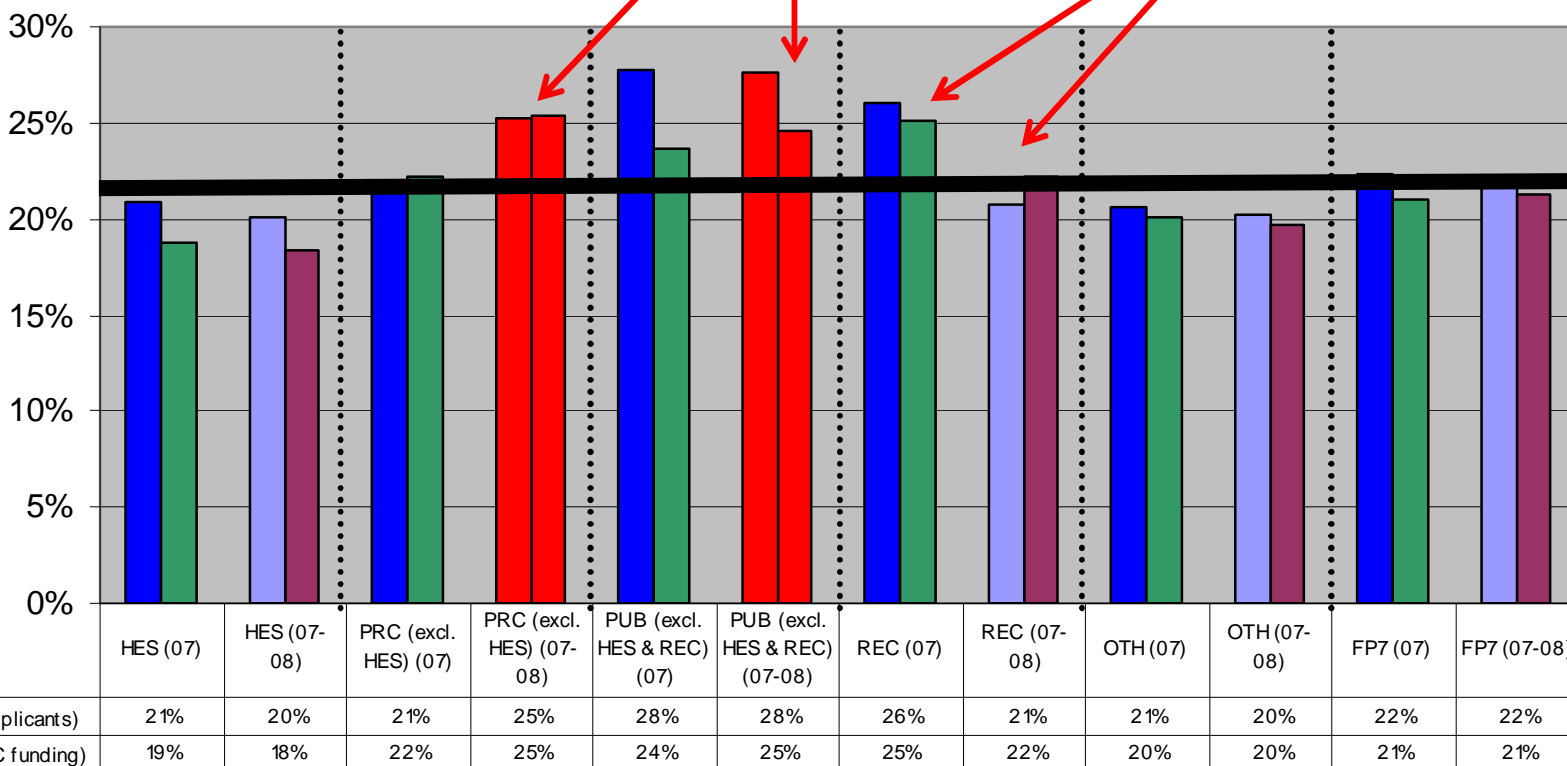


FP7 applicants' success rates

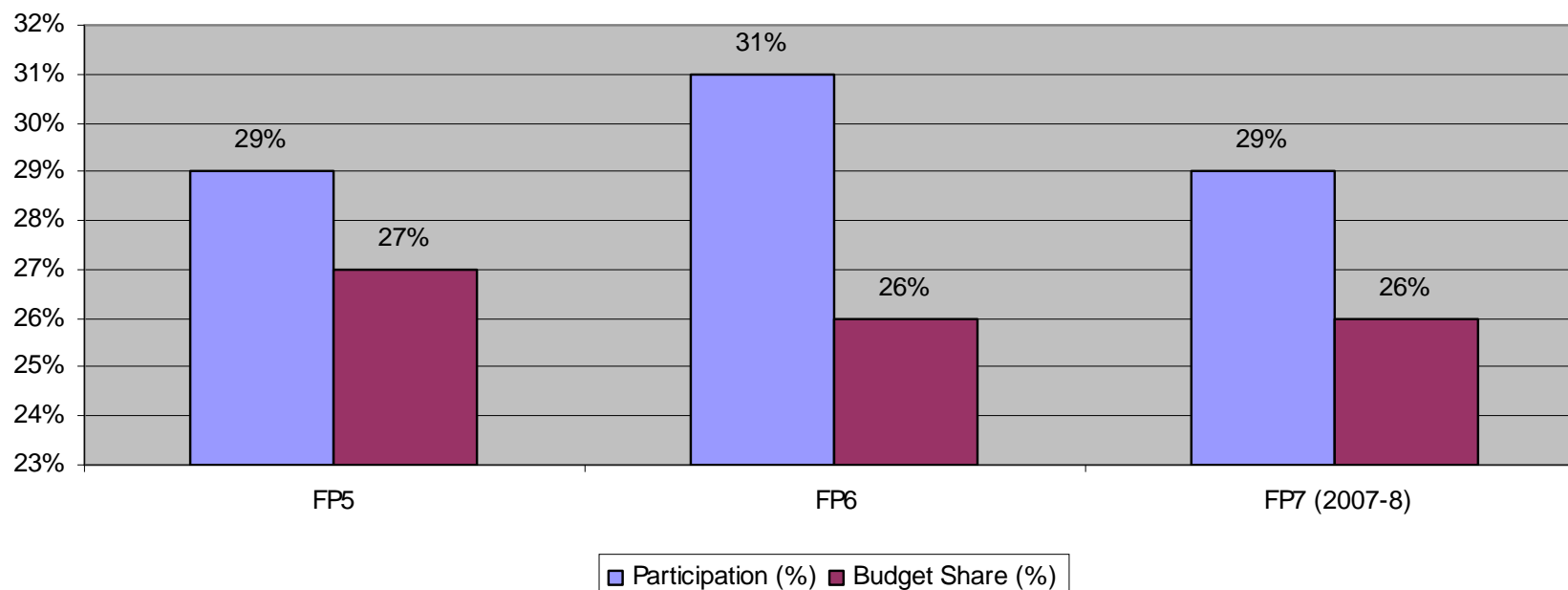

Strong SME Participation in FP7 signed grants

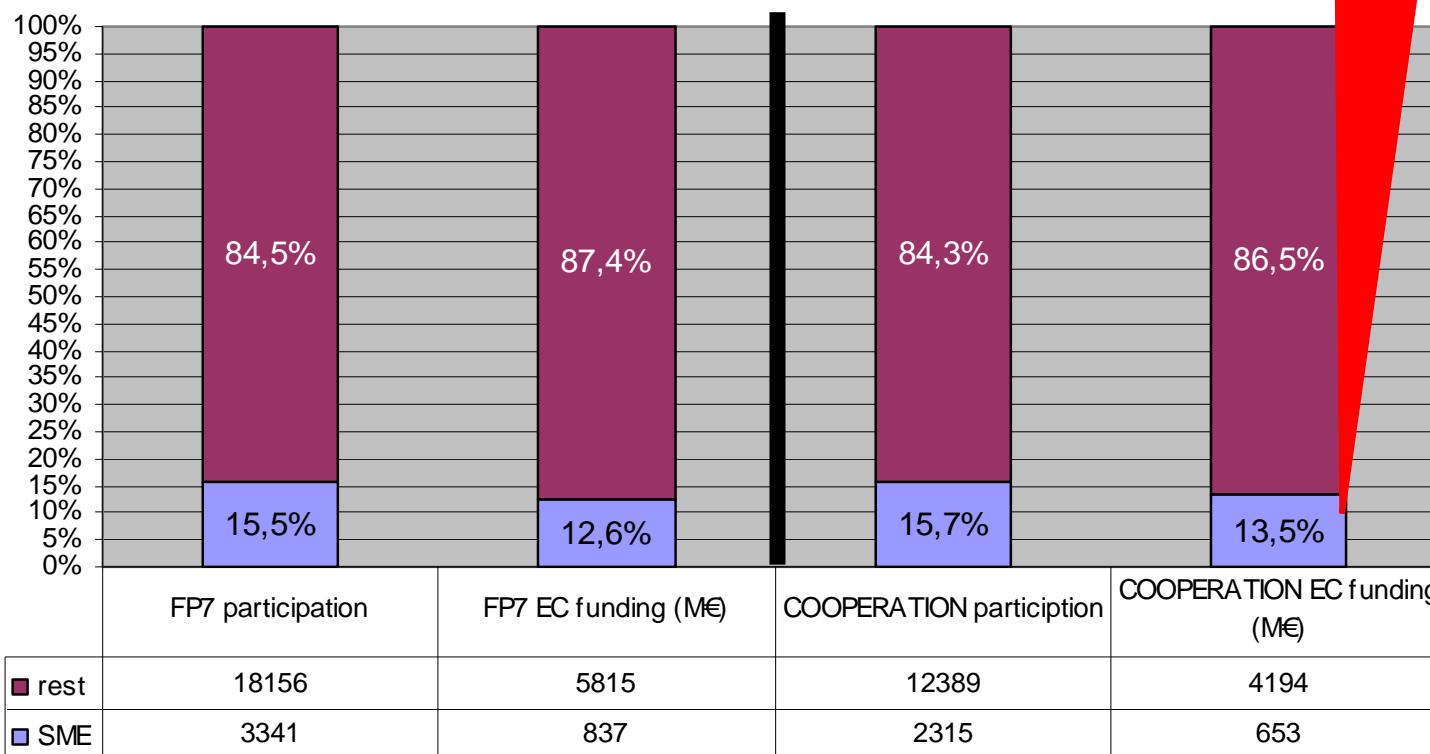
- At last, data on SME grant holders (in signed grants) is validated and reliable,
- They indicate a strong SME participation on FP7:
 - ✓ 15,5 of participations
 - ✓ 12,6% budget share
- Under FP6 (estimated):
 - ✓ 16% of total FP6 participation
 - ✓ 11% of total EC funding

Fig. 17. SME participation and budget share in FP7 signed grant agreements





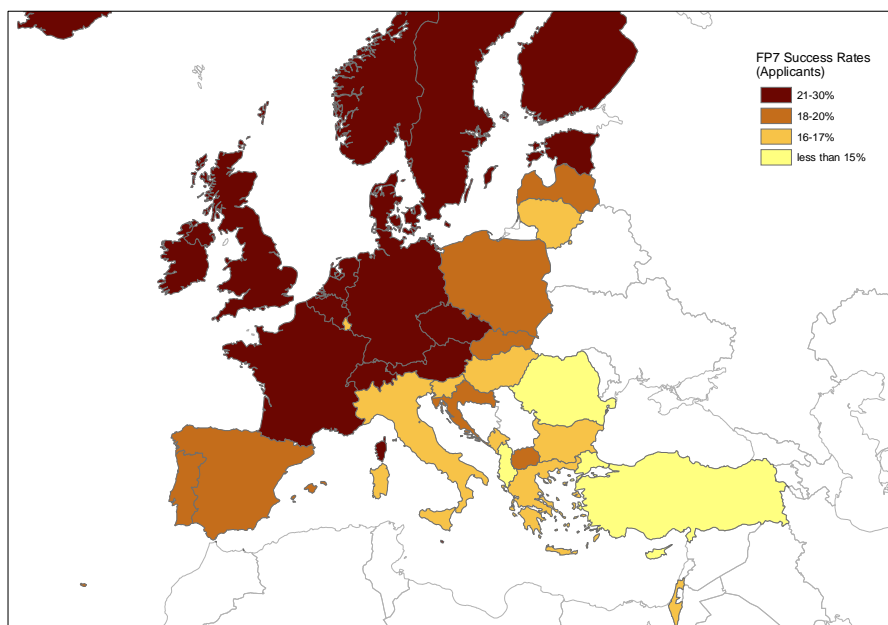

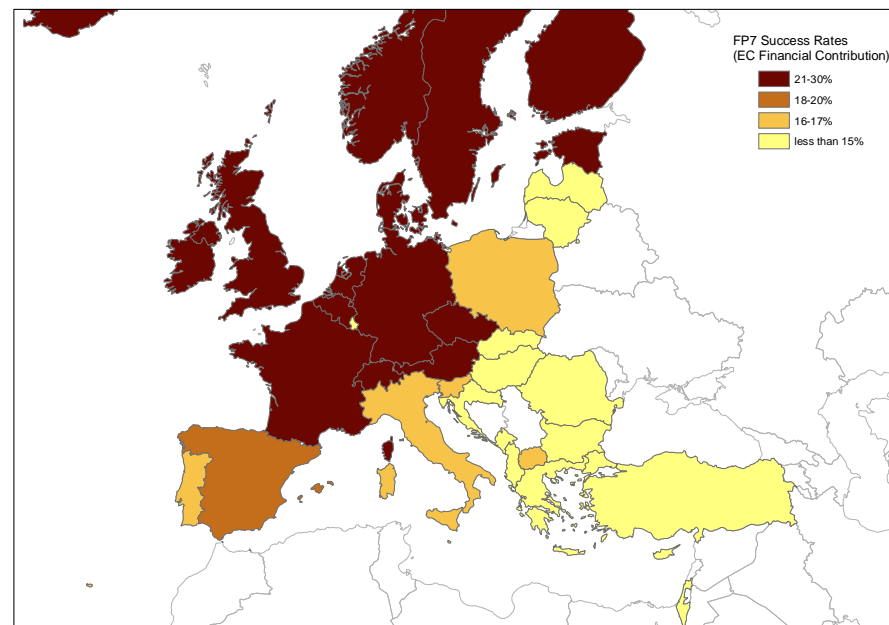

(EC funding)



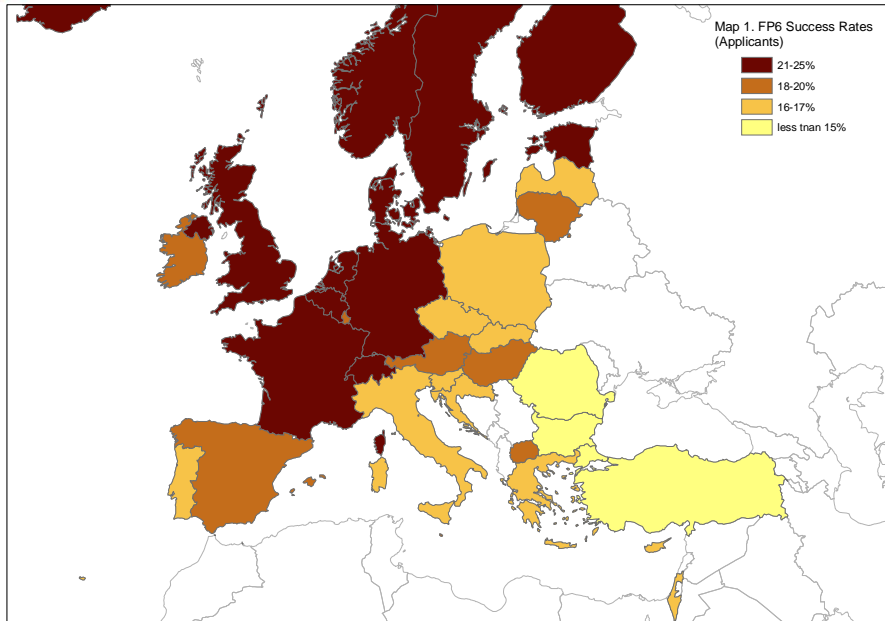

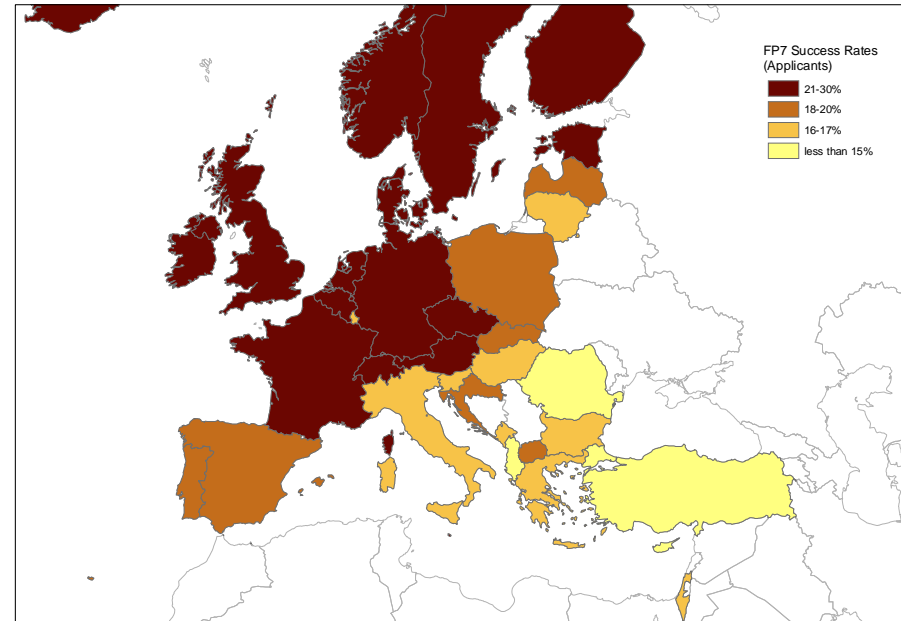

FP7 success rates (applicants)



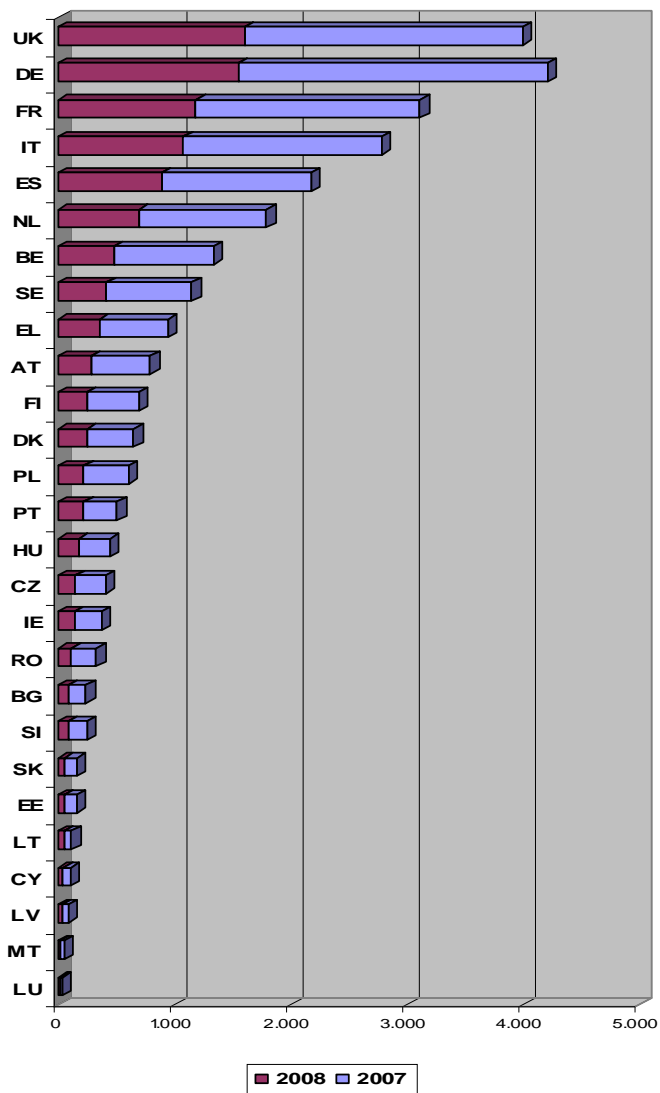

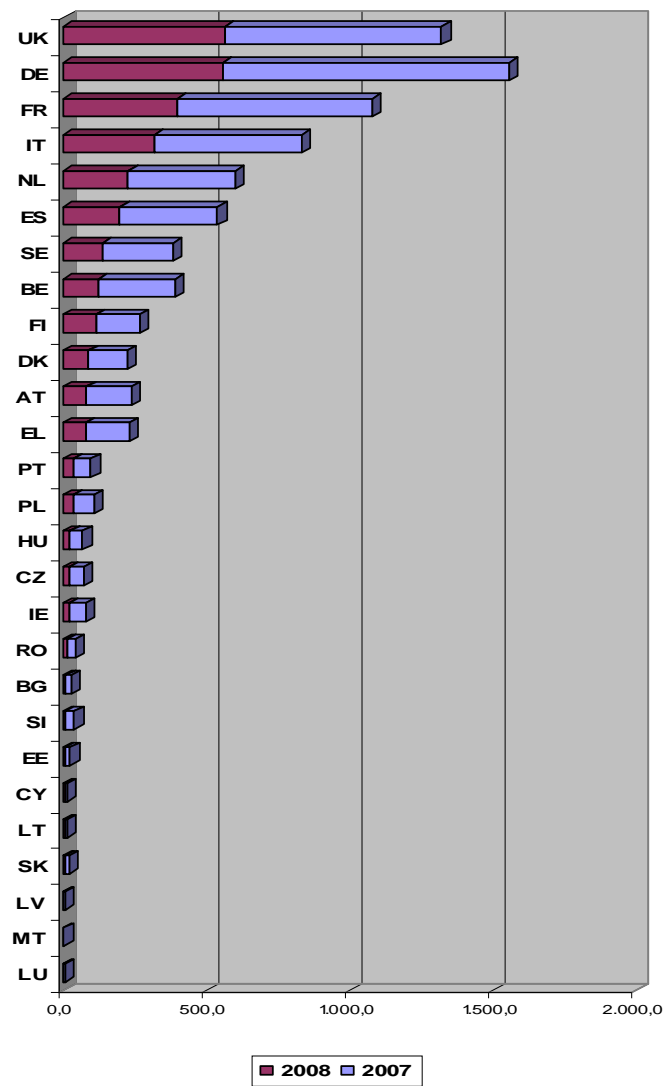
